

# AVIATION SCHOLARSHIPS



The International Council of Airshows Foundation is pleased to offer a number of aviation scholarships to help the pilots, aircraft mechanics, performers and flight instructors of the future complete the necessary training (certificate and degree training) to reach their goals. Scholarship amounts range from \$1,500 up to \$4,000.

For 2013, our scholarship committees will consider all scholarship applications received during the calendar year, and make their selections in January 2015. We will be accepting applications now through December 31, 2014. The following scholarships are available:

## ICAS Foundation GAMA \$2,000

The Foundation has collaborated with the General Aviation Manufacturers Association (GAMA) to provide assistance to students seeking an aviation-related degree. The recipient must have completed at least two semesters with an aviation-related declared major, and have an established trajectory towards completion of their degree.

## Jan Jones Memorial \$2,000

The Jan Jones Memorial Scholarship provides a grant to be applied towards aerobatic training. The recipient must be a female, hold a private pilot's license, and write a short essay on why she wants to learn aerobatics.

## Sean DeRosier Memorial \$1,500

The Sean DeRosier Memorial Scholarship honors Sean's spirit by assisting other young men and women in their aviation goals. The recipient must be a male or female between the ages of 17 and 31. Recipient must use the scholarship to acquire aerobatic flight training (a private pilot's license is required) or an A&P license (a private pilot's license is not required)

## Lovlace-Drake Memorial \$2,000

The Lovlace-Drake Memorial Scholarship recipient must be a holder of a Private Pilot Certificate or international equivalent and be at least sixteen years of age. The applicant must also indicate how he or she will, in turn, make a contribution of service back to the aviation community. This scholarship is to be used for tailwheel and aerobatic flight training.

## French Connection Memorial \$2,000

The French Connection Memorial Scholarship is seeking a male and a female flight instructor who need financial help acquiring aerobatic training so he or she can do a better job teaching or to seek a position giving aerobatic instruction. The recipient must be a certified flight instructor (CFI), and must use the scholarship for aerobatic flight training.

## Marion Cole Scholarship \$4,000

The Marion Cole Scholarship is intended to help create new and more skilled aviators, and encourage them to become the teachers and mentors of the future. The applicant must be at least 16 years old and be an aspiring aviator who is interested in primary flight training or in aerobatic training, but the emphasis of the award will be in encouraging young people who are interested in the aviation or air show business.

## Charlie Hillard Memorial \$2,000

The Charlie R. Hillard Scholarship provides a grant to begin or continue flight training and is open to those between the ages of 18 and 30.

## Greg Koontz Airshows Scholarship for Aerobatics Instructor 4-day/8-lesson aerobatic course

The Greg Koontz Airshows Scholarship is available to Certified Flight Instructors who express a desire to become a qualified aerobatic instructor. Applicants are expected to have some level of tangible exposure to aerobatic flying and have not passed their 25th birthday.
